



Speaker Appreciation Program

The Speaker Appreciation Program was created as a way of saying thank you to all of our incredible insurance professionals for the wonderful work they do each day helping to educate the public about insurance-related issues.

Rewards

❖ Speakers can be recognized and rewarded MONTHLY in the following ways:

- Upon completion of each presentation (and receipt of the Report Form) speakers are eligible to receive a \$5 gift card to Starbucks, Barnes & Noble, Best Buy, or other approved establishment. The speaker or NW Insurance Council staff can initiate presentations. To be eligible for the reward, we ask that the Report Forms be turned in *no later than 30 days* from the date the speech was given.

For Example, if 2 presentations are done at a high school in one day, and the Report Form is received no later than 30 days from the speech date, a speaker would receive two \$5 gift cards or one \$10 gift card.

❖ Speakers can be recognized and rewarded ANNUALLY in the following ways:

- At each NW Insurance Council Annual Luncheon, all speakers who complete one or more presentations (and turn in their Report Form(s) prior to the luncheon) will be recognized with a certificate of appreciation for speeches given between January 1st and December 31st of the previous calendar year.
- Speakers can also be recognized for their Years of Service*

| Five | \$25 gift card |
| Seven | \$30 gift card |
| Nine | \$35 gift card |

| Twenty | \$75 gift card |
| Twenty-five + | \$100 gift card |

- The three speakers with the most presentations completed during the previous calendar year will receive gift cards to Starbucks, Barnes & Noble, Best Buy, or other approved establishment.
